



As an employer it's our duty to prevent or adequately control

employee exposure to dust with softwood dusts having a Workplace Exposure Limit

with dust extractors to create a healthier working environment for our teams and other

Most panels Fieldmans use contain a chipboard core, which can release harmful softwood dust when cut. To reduce this, the 'local exhaust ventilation' controls the dust at the source as it's produced - collected directly from the bandsaw vacuum hose, preventing a large percentage of dust entering the work environment.

As well as the health benefits, the dust extractors also have an automatic on/off switch to control energy and the vacuums can be used on both wet and dry extraction - ideal for our 'tidy as you go' policy. Green and clean!

I'm truly proud of our commitment to improving the way we do business to limit our impact on the environment – this year we have already invested new eco-friendly initiatives and I look forward to bringing you more eco-developments throughout 2015 as we aim to lead the way in bettering work practices within the industry.


